CALL FOR PARTNERSHIP

1. Background

The Government of Uganda through its Ministry of Water and Environment (MoWE) jointly with the Albertine Rift Conservation Society (ARCOS) and in collaboration with partners in a global programme "Sustainable Mountain Development for Global Change (SMD4GC)" financially and technically supported by the Swiss Agency for development and Cooperation (SDC)" are organising the third World Mountain Forum (WMF) to take place on 17th-20th October 2016 in Mbale, Uganda

(wmf.mtnforum.org). The WMF is a platform for Sustainable Mountain Development Stakeholders that takes place on a bi-annual basis. The first WMF was held in Lucerne, Switzerland on 11-12 October 2011 and the second was held in Cusco, Peru on 23-24 May 2014 where Uganda made the proposal to host WMF 2016 and it was granted.
